THE ECHO OF THE SHADOW Teatro de los Sentidos

What would you do to discover the most essential part of yourself? How far would you go to bring it back?

From its home in Barcelona, **Teatro de los Sentidos** (Theatre of the Senses) has been weaving works of extraordinary intimacy and immersiveness for 25 years. Now, in an Australian exclusive presented by Melbourne Festival with ACMI, Melbourne can witness an astonishing work for one person at a time in *The Echo of the Shadow* - a depth charge plumbing the most inner recesses of our being.

Inspired by Hans Christian Andersen's novel, *The Shadow*, a dark tale about a man who is afraid to follow his own, the audience is invited to enter a sensorial labyrinth that has been created for one person to experience in isolation. A physical journey designed to spark emotional responses, they will take on an active role as they become travellers in a symbolic and dreamlike experience.

A cross between a European style fairy tale and sensory therapy, this 75 minute adventure stimulates all five senses. Guided by the productions softly eccentric performers and inhabitants, through listening, smelling, tasting and touching, the audience experience various encounters along the way that aim to unfurl memories long forgotten memories and discover dreams of the future.

"Teatro de Los Sentidos (Theatre of the Senses) have been the world's gold standard for immersive and transformational theatre over the past three decades", said Melbourne Festival Artistic Director, Jonathan Hollway.

"*Echo* is one of the best theatrical experiences I have ever had, so to bring it to Australia for the first time is thrilling. A show for one person at a time might seem like dropping a pebble into a lake, but the ripples will be felt for years to come."

Founded 25 years ago by anthropologist and Artistic Director **Enrique Varga**, they have created 12 original, innovative and experiential works to date that open boundaries between theatre and audience using experimental methods of communication. They have visited Australia once before in 2012 with a sold out season of *Oraculas* as part of Jonathan Holloway's first Perth International Arts Festival.

The Company's approach is based on corporeal and sensory communication, the importance of play, ancestral traditions, and silence as a necessary condition for communication. Their shows are the final result of their research on the relationship between body memory, sensory languages and theatrical creation.
